The nomination shall be submitted to any officer prior to February 16th, 2019. A Moose Legionnaire must be in good standing with his lodge and must have at least six (6) months good standing Moose Legion membership in his Moose Legion, preceding May 1 of the year of his election. He must also have successfully completed an authorized Moose Legion Educational Conference (MLEC) within Three (3) years prior to assuming office.

To be considered for the office of president a Moose Legionnaire must complete at least one (1) year in another elected office of the Moose Legion in which he seeks office, and complete an authorized educational conference within the require time frame.

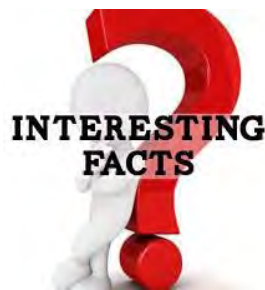
